Campground Information and Rules

- The Pepper Ranch Campground is open for tent camping October 24, 2014 through May 2015, on Friday and Saturday nights. The campground will be closed for public hunting: Feb 27-March 1, March 13-15, April 10-12 and June 5-7, 2015.
- Campsites are tent-only with a limit of 2 tents / 5 people per site.
- Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. and check-out time is 12:00 p.m. Check-ins after 4:00 pm will need to have previously called 239-252-2961 for gate code.

Campers and preserve visitors are subject to rules listed in Collier County Ordinance No. 2011-38 as amended, some of which are listed below.

- Campers please park in designated parking lot overnight. Cars may be parked at each site for loading and unloading. Overflow parking and for vehicles with trailers is allowed in the grassy area next to the parking lot.
- No feeding or harassing wildlife. Keep food locked in vehicles. All garbage must be disposed of in bear-proof receptacles.
- All plants, animals and park property are protected. The collection, destruction or disturbance of plants, animals and County property is prohibited. Do not tie rope or chain around trees.
- Pets are not permitted due to high predator populations.
- Fires are allowed in designated areas only. Do not leave campfires unattended.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Hunting is only allowed during scheduled hunts with a valid Pepper Ranch Preserve Hunt Permit.
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited.
- Firewood is <u>not</u> available on-site for purchase.
- Smoking is prohibited on hiking trails and in picnic areas.
